AREAS OF APPLICATION

Internal use, releasable or permanent installation.

SUBSTRATES

Concrete, ARDEX self-levelling underlayments, wood, terrazzo and existing resilient floor coverings or as recommended by the floor covering manufacturer.

FLOOR COVERINGS

For the following structures:

- · Vinyl-Backed Carpet Tiles
- Vinyl Composition Tiles (VCT)
- Luxury Vinyl Tiles (LVT)
- Certain Carpet Pad/Cushion Underlay

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

Must be level & smooth, clean, permanently dry, sound & firm, load-bearing, free of cracks, have sufficient tensile and compressive strength and must be prepared accordingly. Remove dirt, wax, loose paint and all other foreign matter that would interfere with a good bond such as curing agents & sealers.

If excessively porous, prime with ARDEX P51 diluted 1:3 with clean water.

PRIMING

Required on porous substrates. Use ARDEX P51 diluted 1:3 with clean water.

INSTALLATION

Refer to the floor covering manufacturer's recommendations. Condition adhesive and floor coverings to working area temperature for 24 hours prior to and 48 hours after installation.

Installation temperature of working area and substrate to be a minimum of 10° C and a maximum of 35° C.

Stir adhesive prior to use.

Fully cover & evenly spread the adhesive over the suitably prepared substrate to obtain the recommended coverage as required for the relevant floor covering using a paint roller, brush, notched trowel or flat edge trowel. Avoid concentrations of adhesive.

Releasable Installation (all floor coverings)

Allow the adhesive to 'set-up/tack-up' until dry to touch; approximately 30 - 60 minutes. When dry to touch, the adhesive will be tacky with no transfer to fingers or floor covering.

The set-up time will vary depending on job conditions, substrate, temperature and humidity. Cut, install and fit coverings within 24 hours ensuring that there has been no prior contamination of the adhesive. Roll the flooring in both directions using a recommended roller (normally 35 - 50kg).

"The floor covering can then be repositioned at any time".

Permanent Installation

(Vinyl-Backed Carpet Tile & VCT&LVT)

Allow adhesive to become tacky but not dry to touch.

(Carpet Pad/Cushion Underlay)

Install immediately into wet adhesive.

Protect carpet floor coverings from exposure to water from cleaning & other sources for a minimum of 30 days after installation.

CLEAN UP

Wet: Clean with warm soapy water
Dry: Clean with mineral spirits carefully
following warnings on container

SHELF LIFE

One year from date of manufacture in unopened container.

Protect from freezing and direct sunlight.

COVERAGE

approx. 8-12m²/L using a short nap paint paint roller or smooth edge trowel approx. 5 - 6.5m²/L using an A2 trowel (will vary depending on substrate porosity)

PACKAGING

20 Litre plastic pail containing 20kg of adhesive
